

Infiltrator IM Series Tanks

Over the years we have used many different plastic style septic tanks with varying results. We had some of then float out of the ground. We had issues with crushing when native dirt was used for backfill. We had weak walled risers which deformed and would not allow the lids to seat properly.

As plastic tanks were easier to install and non-reactive to the gasses in septic systems, we chose to use them in spite of various problems.

Then Infiltrator introduced the IM series, an entirely new type of tank. As you can see from the pictures it does not look like any other tank made in the U.S.

Although lightweight it is exceptionally strong. When it has been correctly installed, it will not float even when pumped out. The risers are rugged and easy to install.

The feature we like best is the ability to combine tanks in multiple configurations. For example, if you need a 1,000 gallon septic tank and a pump or siphon vault, you can combine an IM 1060 and an IM 540 and place them side by side (to save space), end to end or move the 540 further downstream to facilitate dosing. While not impossible this would be difficult with concrete tanks and other plastic tanks.

When one buys their first tank from us, when we deliver it, we teach the installer how to install and configure the tanks.
